Where is in the next few year plans to expand operations – EAST CHAMPARAN, WEST CHAMPARAN AND SUPAUL.



Progress for the period of April, 2024 to March, 2025.

1. BSLD PROJECT BANDRA Supported by Heifer International

(Bihar Sustainable Livelihood Project -Bandra)

Our organization supported to 4000 poorest families after formed. During intervention our team started several innovative type livelihood activities for increase to yearly income for member of SHG. selected poorest family at ten panchayat of Bandra Blocks. Our team provided different type training topics on women empowerment, institutional development and economic development under 12 cornerstones. Our project team to linkage with bankers for loan, linkage to agriculture university for capacity building for income generation activity, Our project team also provided capacity building training and in the monthly meeting on grass roots level income generation activity like goat rearing, Poetry, Model Kitchen garden, SRI, SWI, organic farming with making process of organic manure like Vermin compost and coordination compost pit, credit linkage with branches of nationalized bank like Utter Bihar Gramin Bank and CANARA BANK. Our organization also supported revolving fund to member of SHG per member 10,000 rupees for goat rearing and 3100 rupees for Poetry supported by Heifer international (Funding agencies), Our organization also supported for collective approach like share cropping and women based farmer producer company Limited under Company Act 2013.

Our organization has done key activity under project of BSLD project Bandra like

- * SHG formation- 200 SHG and coverage to 4000 family women member.
- * trained to board member of FPO, registration after Govt.of india under company Act 2013. (Women farmer producer company Ltd. Bandra)
- * Training for SHG strengthen Disaster Risk Reduction (77 Units 1540 women's), Topics on Gender (99Units 1800 women's), minimize to the chemical fertilizer and appreciated to organic farming
- * 12 CORNERSTONE based training (Passing of gift, Responsibility, distribution and care, self-reliance, Improved Animal Management (55Units 1100 women's) V,

Nutrition and income, Gender equality, Priority base need and Justice, improve to environment, full participation, training and communication, spirituality.

* Goat rearing – training provided of improve animal management and provided revolving fund 202 beneficiary

To beneficiary 330 poorest women entries fund to amount of Rs. 20920633 (Twenty-Nine Lakh Nanty two Six hundred thirty-three Rs. Only)

* Poetry – training with revolving fund per family (for poetry with shade) to 35units amount of Rs. 325500/

* Goat collection center 2 units- 100000 rupees for self-entrepreneur (Ten women)

* Goat enterprises development

* Kitchen Garden -

* Credit Linkage for goat rearing – Per member 20000 rupees for 4 goats. 23 JLG formed and provided credit linkage amount of Rs 2300000

* Provided training for Non formal education of member of illiterate women (Value Based Literacy Program)

*Goat Immunization cover -6000 and health camp organize for goat (4 camp).
Deforming- 12000

* Fodder plantation 6000 plant in ten panchayats for fodder with environmental improving

* Azola farming 65 units: This is also environmental improving environment

* Re oriented the CAVE as the grass root level doctor like primary treatment for the goat after 10 days training.

2. Maitri Project Supported by Educate Girl

Kanchan Seva AshraM has implemented to the Maitri project Supported by Educate Girl. This is a target based project. Main purpose of the project is enrolment of out of school girl (OOSG). We have identified of the OOSG through

door to door survey and found OOSG children 3903 through PMS app. After survey our team has enrolled to the 2143 OOSG and target against 2000 OOSG. After enrolment our team has done seal sign with school's HM of the enrolment girls. This program is appreciated to out of school girl.

Challenge: 1. Laciness of the document of the OOSG.

3. Headmaster's inelegancy and Arbitrary or willfulness.
4. Not interested some SC family to read the girls in school due to girls are involved in the income generation activity.
5. Some girls were not interested to read due to her community's culture and environment was not like for read.
6. Behave of the School's administration are also effected to the drop out girls.

- Door to Door survey to 78500 House Hold
- HH marking to all of targeted area.
- Preparation of the map to all targeted House Hold
- Training to the project team about survey and PMS app and Survey CTO for cross verification has completed with quality.
- Enrolment to 2143
